

Mag. Gerald Mayer

Gerald Mayer, born in 1971, will join the Management Board of voestalpine AG as the Group's Chief Financial Officer (CFO) on April 1, 2024.

Mayer graduated in economics from the Johannes Kepler University Linz before qualifying as a tax consultant in Austria and a Certified Public Accountant in Chicago, USA, in 2000. After starting his professional career at ICON Wirtschaftstreuhand GmbH in Linz, in 2000 Mayer moved to VA Technologie AG where he progressed through a series of management roles. During this time, his responsibilities included the financial integration following VA Tech's acquisition by Siemens.

Since 2007, Gerald Mayer has been CFO at international AMAG Austria Metall AG, responsible for financing, controlling, group accounting, and legal affairs. Amongst others, he was in charge of metal management, including AMAG's international joint venture Alouette for whom he acted as Chairman for the period 2013-2015. In 2019, Gerald Mayer was also promoted to CEO of AMAG, Austria's largest aluminum-processing company.

Besides, Gerald Mayer has been a Board Member of the Federation of Austrian Industries (IV) since 2019, and a Member of the Executive Committee of the European Aluminium Association since 2020.
